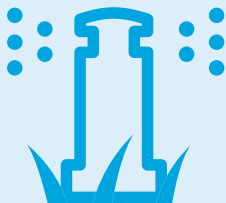
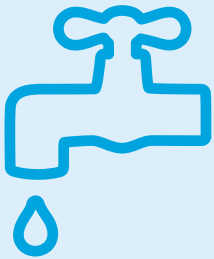

- A quantified weekly cost for each water use area. The result might surprise you!

Who is eligible?

SAMPLE REPORT



Congratulations! Living Water Smart has completed your Water Use Health Check. Please find below your results and our water saving recommendations. (Note—all findings are based on logger data at your water meter. You may wish to make further investigations to confirm your results.)

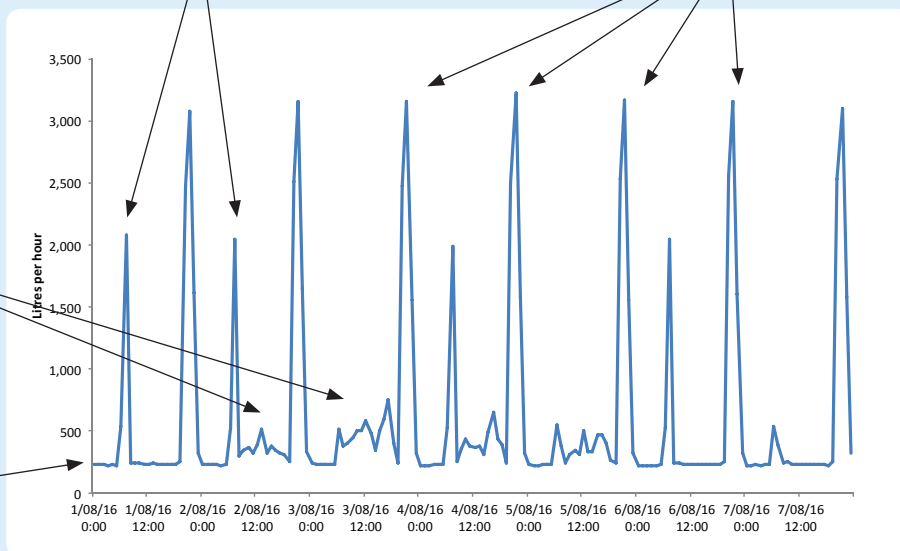
Your water use:

4 days a week irrigation—2000L/hr

Daily irrigation—3000L/hr

Normal daytime water use

Probable leak—constant flow at about 230L/hr



Estimated water volumes used:

	Litres per week	Dollars per week
Irrigation	59,000	\$114
Constant leak	39,000	\$74
Other use	5,000	\$10

Leaks

It appears that you may have a constant leak of about 230 litres per hour (equivalent to 25 buckets). The graph above should normally drop to zero at some stage throughout the day or night but a consistent base flow has been identified that is likely costing your business around \$3 800 per year.

Garden Irrigation

It appears that you use about 59,000 litres per week on garden irrigation (equivalent to 245 wheelie bins). If this use continued across an average seven-month dry season it would cost about \$3 300 per year.

Available Rebate—You are eligible for a Garden Tune Up rebate. A registered Living Water Smart irrigation supplier will come to your business to discuss your irrigation system, undertake a few quick fixes if required and provide you with an efficient irrigation schedule tailored to your garden.
